Nashville, TN - Outpatient Imaging Affiliates, LLC ("OIA") today announced a series of expansions and promotions laying the foundation for an aggressive post-DRA strategy for the company. The Deficit Reduction Act of 2005 has created its share of turmoil in the industry, but according to OIA President and Chief Executive Officer Frank Kyle, OIA is well positioned to continue the growth it has experienced since its inception in 2000. "OIA was formed with the premise of owning and operating outpatient imaging centers in partnership with local hospitals and radiologists, matching their reputations and physician relationships with our management and marketing expertise," Kyle says. "Despite all of the industry talk about national consolidation, our belief has not changed - radiology is and always will remain a local service and locally is where consolidation should and will take place."

Consistent with OIA's joint venture model, the company today announced the creation of St. John's Imaging, LLC, a joint-venture between OIA and the radiology group Drs. McClow, Clark & Berk, PA. St. John's Imaging will provide MR, CT, PET/CT and other outpatient diagnostic services to patients and referring physicians in the greater Jacksonville area. The center, scheduled to open in the spring of 2008, will be developed and managed by OIA.

Scott Shill, M.D., a partner with Drs. McClow, Clark & Berk and the Medical Director for St. John's Imaging, cites the many unknowns in the industry as one of the reasons for partnering with OIA. "Radiology is facing many obstacles including declining reimbursement and increased competition. Despite these factors, patients and referring physicians have a continuing need for access to high-quality, patient-friendly outpatient imaging services with sub-specialty interpretive services. After evaluating several options, we felt partnering with OIA, given their reputation and track record in other markets, was the best way to bring these services to our community and provides us with our best chance for success."

OIA is also announcing today the expansion of its relationship with Raleigh Radiology Associates in North Carolina via the addition of new locations in the Raleigh suburbs of Wake Forest, Brier Creek and Clayton. Raleigh Radiology Wake Forest opened the last week of September in order to better serve patients and referring physicians in Northern Wake and Franklin Counties. Likewise, Raleigh Radiology Clayton, focused on Johnson County and surrounding markets, will open in October. Each will initially offer mobile MRI with the potential to add other imaging services. Additionally, Raleigh Radiology has received a Certificate of Need approval to open a diagnostic imaging center in Brier Creek, a rapidly growing market in Northeast Raleigh.

"Raleigh consistently ranks near the top of every fast growing cities list" explains Kyle. "With the addition of these locations, plus other sites currently being evaluated by OIA and RRA, we are continuing to implement our strategy of a broader geographic network of centers to meet the needs of the fast growing Raleigh population and expanding referring physician base just as we are with our radiology and hospital partners in other areas of the country."

In order to keep Outpatient Imaging Affiliates well positioned to provide experienced and knowledgeable resources to its partners, OIA also announces the following promotions and new hires:

- Kelly Gill, a seasoned senior executive with 22 years of highly successful healthcare experience across multiple disciplines, was promoted to the position of Chief Operating Officer.
